I. Call to Order Open Session:

Chair Cliff Bowers called the Open Session to order at 6:30 PM.

II. A. Public Input:

II. B. Student Input:

Jenson Kaithamattam gave the student report and presented his class project.

II. C.2. 2016-2017 School Committee Goals: Superintendent's Professional Practice Goal

The School Committee's goals for 2016-2017, which were developed at the Goals Workshop on July 25, 2016 and August 29, 2016 were reviewed and approved.

<u>The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Venezia and seconded by Ms. Koepke to approve the North Reading School Committee Goals and Action Plan for 2016-2017. Motion passed 5-0.</u>

II. C.3. Fiscal Year 2018 North Reading Public School's Capital Improvements Plan

The School Committee reviewed the FY18 Capital Improvement Plan and the priority list. The Capital Improvement Plan needs to be submitted to the Capital Improvement Planning Committee by October 1, 2016.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Venezia and seconded by Ms. Imbriano to approve the three year Capital Improvement Plan as submitted with the exception of #5 - to move the Hood School modular demolition to FY19 for consideration. Motion passed 5-0.

II. D.1. Proposal: North Reading Middle School Washington, D.C. Trip

Ms. O'Connell (Principal, NRMS) presented a proposal for a Grade 8 student trip to Washington, D.C. (June 12-16, 2017).

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Venezia and seconded by Ms. Imbriano to approve the annual Grade 8 Washington, D.C. trip from June 12-16, 2017 and the alternative day trips for those not attending the Washington, D.C. trip. Motion passed 5-0.

II. D.2. North Reading Middle School General Arts Schedule

Ms. O'Connell (Principal, NRMS) and Mr. Maloney (Vice Principal, NRMS) reviewed the North Reading Middle School General Arts Schedule that has been recently developed.

II. D.3. Proposal: North Reading High School Student Council Conference; Hyannis, MA

II. D.5. Proposal: Naming of a School Facility

The Secondary Schools Building Committee has provided a consensus to move forward with the proposal that the Distance Learning Lab at the North Reading Middle/High School be named in honor of former Superintendent of Schools Dr. David S. Troughton.

The next steps that the School Committee will take are to (1) establish a subcommittee to review and evaluate all the suggested names to be considered; (2) establish a deadline of submission of names to said Screening Committee (the deadline date was established as October 28, 2016); (3) set a date for a public hearing for the purpose of garnering input from the community with respect to the naming of a school facility. Persons interested in participating on the Screening Committee should send written request to Superintendent Bernard.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Venezia and seconded by Ms. Imbriano to approve the formation of a Screening Committee to consider the renaming of the North Reading Middle/High School Distance Learning Lab. Motion passed 5-0.
