I. Call to Order Open Session

Chair Scott Buckley called the Open Session to order at 6:32 pm.

II. A. Public Input: There was no public input.

II. B. Student Report:

Ms. Sophia Galuppo, Class of 2022, shared the student report and her class work.

II. C.1. Reopening Update:

Dr. Daly addressed updates on the progress of our schools in reopening for the fall in the hybrid model. Updates included communication about the Covid-19 community level data, hybrid model, extra-curricular activities, and athletics. He also gave a brief update on the Professional Development Day on November 3, 2020.

II. C.2. Large Capital Presentation:

Mr. Michael Connelly, Assistant Superintendent of Finance and Operations, provided an update to the Large Capital five-year plan discussed at the October 19, 2020 meeting. The final proposal and recommended priority list was approved by the School Committee.

Priority proposals from each department must be submitted to the Capital Improvements Planning Committee (CIPC) by the end of November.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. McGowan and seconded by Ms. Imbriano to approve the large capital improvement projects and in the priority order presented by the Administration to the Capital Improvement Planning Committee for fiscal year 2022, 2023, and 2024. Motion passed 4-0 on a roll call vote.

II. D.1. School Calendar:

Dr. Daly made recommendations to consider changes to the calendar for the days leading up to Thanksgiving holiday and Winter break.

The Committee voted on a motion by Ms. Imbriano and seconded by Mr. McGowan to amend the current school calendar to allow for remote learning for the days preceding Thanksgiving and Winter break. Motion passed 4-0 on a roll call vote.

II. D.2. Civics Project Update:

Dr. Daly reviewed the Civic Projects students will be participating in vs. Community Service. Both are critical for students and can be overlapped. This will be a non-partisan activity.

There are six stages of Civics Projects. A high-quality student-led civics project aligned to the 2018 History and Social Science Curriculum Framework and Chapter 296 of the Acts of 2018 should include these six stages. Depending on the time available, educators may decide to break down each of the six stages into a larger number of steps.

Stage 1: Examine Self and Civic Identity

Stage 2: Identifying an Issue

Stage 3: Researching and Investigating

Stage 4: Developing an Action Plan

Stage 5: Taking Action

Stage 6: Reflecting and Showcasing

II. D.3. First Reading: Policies

The School Committee conducted a first reading of two policies. The grievance procedures for each policy will be reviewed at future meeting.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Pappavaselio and seconded by Ms. Imbriano to approve the first reading of the Non-Discrimination and Harassment policy labeled AC. Motion passed 4-0 on a roll call vote.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Pappavaselio and seconded by Ms. Imbriano to approve the first reading of the Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 update to our present handbook. Motion passed 4-0 on a roll call vote.

II. D4. School Cancellation and Delay Procedures:

Dr. Daly reviewed the district's updated School Cancellation and Delayed Opening Procedures.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Pappavaselio and seconded by Mr. McGowan to approve the School Cancellation and Delay Opening Procedures for this year. Motion passed 4-0 on a roll call vote.

II. E.2. Budget Update:

Mr. Connelly, Assistant Superintendent of Finance and Operations presented the FY21 budget update reflecting financial activity through the end of October. He also updated the status of Federal Grants associated with the COVID-19 pandemic.
