### I. Call to Order Open Session

# II. B. Student Report:

Ms. Sophia Galuppo, Class of 2022, shared the student report and her class work.

#### II. C.1. Hybrid Learning:

Superintendent Daly provided updates on the progress of our schools in the 2020-21 school year in the hybrid model. Updates included communication about the COVID-19 testing, Little School building temporarily closed due to COVID-19, Dashboard update and continuing the daily emails of COVID-19 cases and frequency of updates, school data, the hybrid model, and other related topics.

### II. D.1. First Reading: Policy JHFB-R

The School Committee reviewed changes to policy JHFB-R, Late Night/Overnight Student Travel.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Pappavaselio and seconded by Ms. Imbriano to approve the first reading of Policy JHFB-R and to keep the "tracked changes" as delineated in the document. Motion passed 5-0 on a roll call vote.

### II. D.2. Fiscal Year 2022 Budget: SEEM Collaborative

Dr. Daly shared the SEEM Collaborative Fiscal Year 2022 budget highlights, which were adopted by the SEEM Collaborative Board of Directors.

### II. D.3. Mid-Year Update: School Improvement Plans

Dr. Daly distributed the Mid-Year Update Report identifying the work that is being done to achieve the goals set forth in each of the School Improvement Plans.

#### II. D.4. Mid-Year Update: School Committee Goals for 2020-21

Dr. Daly recommended that the School Committee conduct a mid-year review of its progress toward meeting its established goals for the 2020-2021 school year. Relevant documents were reviewed to assist in facilitating a discussion among the members of the School Committee. The highlights of the goals document were inserted by Dr. Daly and reflect his determination of goals that the School Committee has addressed to date.

### II. D.5. Superintendent's Evaluation Update

Dr. Daly gave an update on his Educator Evaluation process for this year along with his portfolio and artifacts to date.

# II. E.2. Budget Update:

Mr. Connelly, Assistant Superintendent of Finance and Operations gave an update of the FY21 Budget.

Mr. Connelly also provided an update on the latest information on the status of current and new COVID-19 relief grants available to the School District.

Mr. Connelly also provided an update on the results of the Invitation for Bid (IFB) for regular, athletic, and extra-curricular transportation that was due on January 28, 2021. The pricing information for the 3 and 5 year contract provided by the two bidders was shared and the District's options for awarding the contract were discussed.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. McGowan and seconded by Ms. Boutwell to award the regular transportation contract to North Suburban Transportation from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2024 contingent upon Mr. Connelly going back to them and negotiating on the final years four and five in the contract. Motion passed 5-0 on a roll call vote.
