I. Call to Order Open Session

Chair Scott Buckley called the Open Session to order at 6:30 pm.

II. A. Public Input: There was no public input.

II. B. Student Report:

Ms. Gianna Naulivou, Class of 2022, shared the student report and her class work.

II. C.1. 2020-21 School Year Update:

Superintendent Daly provided updates on the progress of our schools in the 2020-21 school year in the hybrid model. The elementary schools and Middle School were back in school full time this week. Students are incredibly pleased to be in person again. Dr. Daly also discussed the precautions that students should observe during the April vacation next week.

II. D.1. School Start Times / 2021-22 School Calendar

Dr. Daly and members of the School Start Times Committee presented their recommendation to the School Committee.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. McGowan and seconded by Mr. Pappavaselio to approve the school start times for next year, as 8:00 a.m. for Elementary going to 2:15 p.m., and the Middle School and High School starting at 8:30 a.m. and ending at 3:00 p.m. Motion passed 5-0 on a roll call vote.

II. D.2. Batchelder Principal Recommendation

Dr. Daly made his recommendation to the School Committee for the next Principal of the L.D. Batchelder School, Mr. Michael Maloney, who has been serving as the interim principal at the Batchelder School. Dr. Daly thanked all those involved in the Principal Search Committee and the other applicants.

Administrative Updates:

- Dr. Daly acknowledged the elementary student winners of the Cambridge Science Festival Curiosity Challenge.
- Dr. Daly shared the exciting news that Mr. Loprete, Principal of North Reading High School has been awarded Administrator of the Year by the Massachusetts Association of School Councils.

II. D.3. Fiscal Year 2022 Public Budget Hearing

<u>The Committee voted on a motion by Ms. Imbriano and seconded by Mr. McGowan to open</u> the Fiscal Year 2022 Public Budget Hearing at 7:45 pm. Motion passed 5-0 on a roll call vote.

Mr. Connelly, Assistant Superintendent of Finance and Operations, provided an overview of the current status of the FY22 budget.

At the meeting of the Finance Planning Team on April 6 2021, available revenue was identified that indicates the school department's budget gap is currently at \$467,146 from the "Recommended Budget" presented on March 11, 2021.

The "Recommended Budget" of \$34,352,117 for Fiscal Year 2022 represents a \$1,758,901 or 5.4% increase over the Fiscal Year 2021 budget appropriation.

<u>The Committee voted on a motion by Ms. Imbriano and seconded by Mr. McGowan to Close the Fiscal Year 2022 Public Hearing at 8:25 pm. Motion passed 5-0 on a roll call vote.</u>

II. D.4. Second Reading: Policy AEAB

The School Committee reviewed the second reading of Policy AEAB - Holidays.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Pappavaselio and seconded by Ms. Imbriano to approve the second reading of Policy AEAB and to keep the "track changes" as delineated in the document. Motion passed 5-0 on a roll call vote.

The Committee voted on a motion by Ms. Imbriano and seconded by Mr. Pappavaselio to accept the March 22, 2021 Open Session minutes as written. Motion passed 5-0 on a roll call vote.
