Mr. Connelly presented the Large Capital Improvement Plan for fiscal year 2024 through 2028. The revised plan will be submitted to the Capital Improvement Planning Committee (CIPC) for their review.

This communication board is to support inclusivity and accessibility within school playgrounds as well as support children in initiating conversations with peers, navigating social situations and expressing themselves.
