## I. Call to Order Open Session

Chair Scott Buckley called the Open Session to order at 6:30 pm.

#### II. A. Public Input:

John Barrette, 2 Dogwood Lane asked the School Committee to support his request to the North Reading Department of Health and the Department of Public Health for an open forum on the dangers and inefficacy of COVID-19 vaccines and the dangers of children wearing masks. He also stated that it was inappropriate for his name to be used at a staff welcome back meeting at the beginning of the year.

Piper Kirwin, Class of 2024 provided the student report and presented her class work.

## II. D.1. Boys Hockey Overnight Trip Proposal:

Dr. Daly presented a letter from Athletic Director David Johnson to High School Principal AJ Loprete requesting an overnight trip for the Varsity Boys Hockey Team to Falmouth, MA to participate in the Jeff Hayes Memorial Tournament on February 21, 2023.

The Committee voted on a motion by Ms. Rudloff and seconded by Mr. Friedman to approve the Boys Hockey overnight trip. Motion passed 4-0.

Dr. Daly presented a request for a School Committee Award of Appreciation and a discussion about the process for these awards moving forward. After discussion it was agreed to waive the current March 1<sup>st</sup> deadline. The Policy Subcommittee will review Policy KDD and bring it forward for School Committee approval.
