#### II. A. Public Input:

#### II. D.1. Core Measurement Survey:

Ms. Amy Luckiewicz, Drug Free Communities Grant Director, presented the 2023 Core Measurement Survey. Students will have the opportunity to opt out of the survey that will be administered in grades 6-12 in the weeks following April break. Additional questions surrounding gambling have been added to this year's survey.

The School Committee took an unofficial vote and no one is opposed to the CIT conducting this year's survey.

Mr. Michael Connelly, Assistant Superintendent of Finance and Operations, presented updates to the FY2024 recommended school budget and the status of the remaining budget gap. The School Committee will hold another budget workshop on April 26, 2023.

The Committee voted on a motion by Rick McGowan and seconded by Jeff Friedman to close the FY24 Public Budget Hearing at 8:02 pm. Motion passed 5-0.
