I. Call to Order Open Session:

Vice Chair Gerald Venezia called the Open Session to order at 6:01 p.m.

Executive Session:

The Committee voted on a motion by Ms. Imbriano and seconded by Ms. Koepke pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 30A, Section 21, to enter into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing strategy with respect to contract negotiations with the North Reading Education Association (NREA), and to discuss a personnel matter. Motion passed 4-0 on a roll call vote.

At 6:30 p.m. Ms. Imbriano offered a motion to conclude the Executive Session and enter into Open Session. The motion was seconded by Ms. Koepke. Motion passed 4-0 on a roll call vote.

Open Session:

Vice Chair Gerald Venezia called the Open Session back to order at 6:42 p.m.

The North Reading Middle School Hornet Productions provided a sneak peek of their upcoming production of "Once on This Island." The production will be February 2 & 3, 2018 in the North Reading Middle School/High School Performing Arts Center.

III. B. Student Input:

Ms. Jerlin Kaithamattam, gave the student report and presented a sample of her class work.

III. D.1. Presentation: Representatives of the Northeast Metropolitan Vocational School School Committee Goal FCF-III-B-2 Superintendent's Professional Practice Goal

Ms. Judy Dyment, North Reading's Representative to the Northeast Metropolitan Regional Vocational High School; Mr. Jay Pecone, Director of Finance; and Ms. Carla Scuzzarella, Principal, gave a presentation on the programs and initiatives taking place at the Northeast Metro Tech, where students from North Reading are eligible to attend high school vocational education programs.

III. C.2. School Committee Policies: Second Reading School Committee Goal LG-III-A-1 Superintendent's Professional Practice Goal

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Buckley and seconded by Ms. Imbriano to approve the second reading of revised Policy JGI / Students / Physical Restraint of Students and JGI-R / Students / Restraint Prevention and Behavior Support Policy and Procedures. Motion passed 4-0.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Buckley and seconded by Ms. Imbriano to approve the second reading of revised Policy DJED / Fiscal Management / Procurement Requirements. Motion passed 4-0.

III. D.2. Proposal: School Trip: North Reading High School Foreign Language Department

Ms. Amy St. Arnaud, a teacher and K-12 Foreign Languages Curriculum Coordinator, proposed a trip to New York City in November 2018 for NRHS Spanish students.

The Committee voted on a motion by Ms. Imbriano and seconded by Ms. Koepke to approve the High School Spanish Trip to New York City in November 2018. Motion passed 4-0.

III. D.3. Proposal: New Academic Course; North Reading High School School Committee Goal EP-III-7 School Committee Goal EP-III-9

Mr. AJ Loprete, Principal at NRHS, proposed a new academic course (Robotics Academy II (Honors) to be offered to students at NRHS beginning with the 2018-2019 academic year.

The Committee voted on a motion by Ms. Imbriano and seconded by Ms. Koepke to approve a new honors course (Robotics Academy II) at North Reading High School. Motion passed 4-0.

The Northshore Education Consortium, of which the NRPS is a member district and for which Superintendent Bernard serves as a member of the Board of Directors, is seeking to amend the Articles of Agreement. The proposed amendment seeks to add Ipswich as a member district.

The Committee voted on a motion by Ms. Imbriano and seconded by Mr. Buckley to approve the revised Articles of Agreement with the Northshore Educational Consortium to add Ipswich as a member district. Motion passed 4-0.
