#### I. Call to Order Open Session:

Vice Chair Gerald Venezia called the Open Session to order at 6:00 p.m.

## III. D.1. Presentation: L. D. Batchelder School Faculty and Students School Committee Goal FCR-III-B-1 Superintendent's Professional Practice Goal
