## II. D.2. New Club Proposal: North Reading Middle School Gay-Straight Alliance

Dr. Catherine O'Connell, Principal at North Reading Middle School, proposed a new extracurricular activity club for students to be introduced at North Reading Middle School for 2018-2019.

#### II. D.3. Presentation: Elementary School Improvement Plans Superintendent's Professional Practice Goal Superintendent's District Improvement Goal #1

The principals at North Reading Middle School and North Reading High School, Dr. O'Connell and Mr. Loprete, reviewed the progress made to achieve their 2017-2018 School Improvement Plan goals and presented their 2018-2019 School Improvement Plans.

<u>The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. McGowan and seconded by Mr. Webster to</u> <u>accept the North Reading Middle School 2018-2019 School Improvement Plan. Motion</u> <u>passed 4-0.</u>

## II. D.4. Presentation: North Reading High School Seal of Biliteracy Program

Mr. Loprete, Principal at North Reading High School, presented a proposal to adopt a Seal of Biliteracy initiative at North Reading High School to be implemented beginning with the 2018-2019 school year. The Seal of Biliteracy initiative was first introduced in October 2017 as a "focus area" for exploration in 2017-2018 and as part of the "Year Two Update" to "NRPS 2021."

<u>The Committee voted on a motion by Ms. Boutwell and seconded by Mr. McGowan to</u> <u>approve the North Reading High School Seal of Biliteracy program. Motion passed 4-0.</u>

## II. D.5. Proposal: North Reading High School Cooperative Swim Team

Mr. Loprete, Principal at North Reading High School, presented a proposal to form a cooperative swim team with Wilmington High School beginning in the 2018-2019 school year.

<u>The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Webster and seconded by Mr. McGowan to</u> <u>approve the North Reading High School Cooperative Swim Team with Wilmington High</u> <u>School. Motion passed 4-0.</u>

## II. D.6. Proposal: Performing Arts User Fees

Mr. Michael Connelly, Director of Finance and Operations, presented a proposal for the implementation of Performing Arts User Fees, consistent with the provisions of the recently adopted Collective Bargaining Agreement with the North Reading Education Association (NREA).

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Webster and seconded by Ms. Boutwell to accept the administration's proposal to impose a Performing Arts user fee of \$100.00 at the High School, \$75.00 at the Middle School and \$60.00 at the elementary schools for a one-year period, to be reviewed in the spring of the 2018-2019 school year. Motion passed 4-0.
