I. Call to Order:

As the School Committee had yet to reorganize following the Town election held on May 7, 2019, Mr. Bernard, Superintendent, called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. From 6:00 to 6:30 p.m., the School Committee held a workshop in the Principal's conference room at the E.E. Little School to discuss the Superintendent Search Process. At 6:30 p.m. the School Committee moved to the cafeteria for the purpose of conducting its regular meeting, which Mr. Bernard called to order at 6:39 p.m.

Superintendent Bernard advised the School Committee and the public of the passing of Mr. Charles E. Jones, former Middle School Assistant Principal. Superintendent Bernard then asked for a moment of silence.

II. Reorganization of the North Reading School Committee

By policy, an annual reorganization meeting shall take place on the first Monday following Town election. Superintendent Bernard acted as Chairperson for this portion of the meeting.
