I. Call to Order Open Session:

Chair Scott Buckley called the Open Session/Goals Workshop meeting to order at 4:35 p.m. in the Superintendent's Conference Room.

II. Executive Session:

Motion passed 5-0 on a roll call vote.

III. C.1. Ms. Amy Luckiewicz, Drug Free Communities Grant Coordinator; CORE Measurements Survey Results.

Ms. Amy Luckiewicz, Drug Free Communities Grant Coordinator; provided an overview of the results of the CORE Measurements Survey that was administered to students at North Reading Middle School and North Reading High School in the spring 2019. The administration of the survey to students is a requirement of the Drug Free Communities Grant that the Town of North Reading has received.
