I. Executive Session

At 6:00 p.m., the Committee voted on a motion by Mr. McGowan and seconded by Mr. Pappavaselio pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 30A, Section 21, to go into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing contract negotiations with non-union personnel. Motion passed 5-0 on a roll call vote.

At 6:25 p.m. the Committee voted on a motion by Mr. McGowan and seconded by Mr. Pappavaselio to return to Open Session. Motion passed 5-0 on a roll call vote.

II. Call to Order Open Session:

Chair Scott Buckley called the Open Session to order at 6:30 PM.

III. B. Student Report:

There was no student report.

III. C.1. School Committee Policies

Mr. McGowan and Mr. Pappavaselio, members of the Policy Subcommittee presented three policies for a second reading.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. McGowan and seconded by Mr. Pappavaselio to approve the second reading of revised policy GBDA, Appointment and Notification of Coaches. Motion passed 5-0.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. McGowan and seconded by Mr. Pappavaselio to approve the second reading of policy GCA, Compensation Guides and Contracts. Motion passed 5-0.

<u>The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. McGowan and seconded by Mr. Pappavaselio to</u> <u>approve the second reading of policy GCR, Working Conditions and Benefits. Motion</u> <u>passed 5-0.</u>

III. D.1. Report: Opening Day; 2019-2020 School Year

Superintendent Bernard was proud to say that opening day of the 2019-2020 school year was a success. Total preliminary in-district enrollment: 2019-2020 is 2,407 students.

Superintendent Bernard also thanked Wayne Hardacker and his building and grounds team, as well as the central office and administrative staff for their work during the summer to prepare for opening day.

III. D.2. Presentation: Capital Improvements Plan; Fiscal Year 2021

Mr. Connelly, Director of Finance and Operations, reviewed the five-year Capital Improvements Plan, shared the history of the funded Capital improvement projects over the last five years, and provided the rationale for fiscal year 2021 large capital needs.

Priority proposals from each department must be submitted to the CIPC by October 11, 2019.

III. D.3. School Committee Policies

Mr. McGowan and Mr. Pappavaselio, members of the Policy Subcommittee gave a brief overview of the following policies for approval for first reading.

<u>The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. McGowan and seconded by Mr. Pappavaselio to</u> approve the first reading of revised policy GCP, Reinstatement (Sick Leave Benefits). <u>Motion passed 5-0.</u>

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. McGowan and seconded by Mr. Pappavaselio to approve reviewed policy GCAF, Salary Checks and Deductions. Motion passed 5-0.

III. D.4. New Superintendent's Contract

Mr. Buckley, School Committee Chairman, shared the specific benefits, terms and salary for the new Superintendent, Dr. Patrick Daly. The contract will be for a 3 ½ year term, beginning January 2, 2020 with a starting salary of \$170,000 with 3% COLA increases annually for the term of the contract.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Buckley and seconded by Mr. Pappavaselio to approve the Superintendent's employment contract for Dr. Patrick Daly. Motion passed 5-0.

III. D.5. Recommendation for Appointment; Assistant Superintendent

Superintendent Bernard recommended to the North Reading School Committee that Mr. Michael Connelly, Director of Finance and Operations, be appointed to the position of Assistant Superintendent of Finance and Operations, effective immediately. Superintendent Bernard, as designee of the School Committee will enter into contract negotiations with Mr. Connelly.

<u>The Committee voted on a motion by Ms. Imbriano and seconded by Mr. Pappavaselio to</u> <u>approve Mr. Michael Connelly to be the new Assistant Superintendent of Finance and</u> <u>Operations. Motion passed 5-0.</u>
