I. Call to Order Open Session

Chair Scott Buckley called the Open Session to order at 4:00 pm.

School Committee 2020-2021 Goals Workshop

As a team the School Committee reviewed their 2019-2020 School Committee Goals and worked to develop the School Committee's Goals for 2020-2021.

A final plan for all three models will be submitted to the DESE by August 10, 2020. No vote was taken.
