Fifth Grade Supply List - (First Day School Supplies)

- 5 solid color, plastic, two pocket folders
(yellow, red, blue, green, orange)
- 1 black, plastic two pocket folder
- 1 folder, your choice of pattern/picture
- 3 **wide ruled**, spiral, one subject notebooks (red, green, orange)
- 1 marble composition notebook
- 2 boxes of Ticonderoga #2 pencils
- 2 packages of eraser caps
- 6 blue or black ball point pens
- 6 red ball point pens
- 1 package of 24 Crayola colored pencils (traditional, not twistable or erasable)
- Mini pencil sharpener with cover
- 3 yellow highlighters
- 4 fine point black Sharpies
- 2 boxes of thin Expo dry erase markers, black
- 3 large Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 pair student size Fiskars scissors
