I. Call to Order Open Session:

Chair Janene Imbriano called the Open Session to order at 7:01 PM.

II. A. Public Input:

No public input at this time.

II. B. Student Input:

Gabrielle Lanzaro, Class of 2017, provided the student report and presented her class work.

II. C.1. MSBA/SSBC Update:

- a. Work continues to address the punch list items at both the middle school and high school.
- b. Work continues to review (back punch) items for conformance to plans and specifications.
- c. Installation of decorative stone at plaza and landscape areas is nearing completion.
- d. Work continues to cut and fill areas associated with multipurpose and softball fields.
- e. Installation of light pole bases at lower parking lot areas has begun.
- f. Boulders and other unsuitable materials are being removed from lower site.
- g. The next SSBC meeting is December 8, 2015 and December 22, 2015.

II. C.1. Naming of School Facility

The Committee discussed and voted on the naming of a school facility in honor of Mr. Charles Jones. The decision of the School Committee will then be used to generate an appropriate article for inclusion in the June 6, 2016 Town Meeting Warrant.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Venezia and seconded by Mr. Webster to name the Middle School corridor extending from Main Street to the District Administrative offices in honor of Mr. Charles Jones, former teacher and administrator of the North Reading Middle School, and to submit a Warrant Article to the Board of Selectmen for placement on the June 6, 2016 Town Warrant. Motion passed 5-0.

From the Superintendent's Administrative Report:

Superintendent Bernard reviewed the District's commitment to do the right thing in taking spaces that have been named honoring people at the old high school to the naming of similar locations in the new Middle School/High School. The School Committee was in agreement with Superintendent Bernard's plan of placement of the plaques.

II. D.1. Proposal: Establishment of an Ad Hoc Committee

Mr. Venezia and Mr. Webster made a presentation on the establishment of an ad hoc committee with a specific charge to raise funds for a synthetic turf field complex, the details of which are still being worked out, but at this point may include a turf multipurpose field, perhaps a turf baseball diamond and turf softball diamond, and building to include a concession stand, storage, and public lavatories. Irrigation for a grass field to be constructed might also be part of the scope of the project for which funds would be sought as well. At this time, the membership of the committee is likely to include School Committee members, the Superintendent of Schools, the High School Principal, the Athletic Director, member(s) of Parks and Recreation Department/Committee, member(s) of the Board of Selectman, and community members (to be determined).

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Webster and seconded by Ms. Koepke to establish a turf fields committee with the charge of raising funds to construct a turf field at the current Carey Park, public lavatories at the current football turf field, irrigation for the grass practice field(s) being constructed and the softball field, and a new concession stand and storage. This would be an eleven member committee with the length of terms (one, two and three years) staggered. Motion passed 5-0.

II. D.2. Presentation: Draft Orientation Packet for New School Committee Members

Ms. Koepke and Superintendent Bernard presented the draft of the Orientation Packet for New School Committee Members. They presented the draft cover letter which is aimed at (1) serving as the introduction to an orientation packet for new School Committee members; and (2) fulfilling an established goal of the School Committee for 2015-2016.
