I. Executive Session

At 6:48 p.m. the Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Webster and seconded by Mr. Bowers pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 30A, Section 21, to go into Executive Session to discuss the terms and compensation of the Superintendent's contract following the annual evaluation of the Superintendent's performance conducted in November, 2015 and to reconvene in Open Session. The following courses were proposed: Digital Illustration: Academic, Advanced Acting and Stagecraft: Honors, and Advanced Placement Music Theory.
