I. Executive Session

At 6:33 p.m. the Committee voted on a motion by Ms. Imbriano and seconded by Mr. Bowers pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 30A, Section 21, to go into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing the contract negotiations with the Food Service workers, and to return to Open Session.
