IV. D.2. Food Service Employees Contract Agreement

The North Reading School Committee and the North Reading Food Service Employees have reached agreement as a result of collective bargaining negotiations held over the course of the last several months.

In general, the terms of the tentative agreement are as follows:

A three year contract (July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2019) FY17: 2.0% COLA FY18: 2.0% COLA FY19: 2.5% COLA Implementation of an annual evaluation process Elimination of longevity for employees hired after July 1, 2016

The negotiations were conducted in a professional and collaborative manner. Superintendent Bernard would like to thank the Food Service Employees for their cooperation and commitment to the school district. He is also appreciative of the efforts of Mr. Michael Connelly, Director of Finance and Operations, and Ms. Janene Imbriano, North Reading School Committee, for their contributions to the negotiations.

<u>The Committee voted on a motion by Ms. Imbriano and seconded by Mr. Venezia</u> to approve the Food Service Employees Contract for a three year period beginning July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019. Motion passed 5-0.

IV. D.3. Special Project Stipend: Superintendent of Schools

The Superintendent requested a "Special Project" stipend in the amount of \$3,000.00 for his work associated with the Secondary Schools Building Project from the period of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. A provision for a "Special Project" stipend to be awarded the Superintendent is included in his employment contact.

The Committee voted on a motion by Mr. Webster and seconded by Ms. Imbriano to approve the \$3,000.00 "Special Project" stipend for Superintendent Bernard. Motion passed 5-0.
