## **Junior and Senior Power Block Privileges**

Juniors and seniors who maintain good attendance, discipline, and academic records consistent with the Student Code of Conduct and Behavioral Expectations as outlined in the 2023-2024 Student and Parent Handbook are eligible for Power Block privileges.

The list of junior and senior students meeting the criteria will be generated by the Assistant Principal twice each quarter, once at the midpoint and once at the end. This list will be communicated out to teachers. Seniors and juniors who do not meet the criteria will be assigned a regular powerblock classroom. The Assistant Principal will work with individual students and their teachers to generate a plan for meeting the criteria for privileges based on improved attendance, grades, and/or behavior by the time of the next report (mid or end of the quarter).

## **Criteria for Privileges**

- Good academic standing: No grades of 69% or below, or incompletes
- No Unexcused Absences
- No More than three unexcused tardies
- No class cuts, including powerblock
- No violations of academic integrity
- No behavioral problems resulting in being asked to leave a class or space
- No outstanding detentions, unless approval of Assistant Principal
- No suspensions
