<sup>\*</sup>Includes a \$263,450 amount for the Little School Roof Project in which the District is seeking MSBA reimbursement in the amount of 46.58%. The exact cost of this project is unknown. This project will be handled outside of the CIPC large capital process.

#### FY 17 Requests Vehicles

- Special Education Van \$45,000 (FY17)
  - Replace 2006 Wheelchair Van
  - Vehicle has over <u>120,000</u> miles on it.



- New Bobcat Utility Vehicle \$65,000 (FY17)
  - Maintain all schools especially new combined MS/HS Campus
  - Vehicle can sweep, plow snow, front load, cut grass, etc.

#### FY 17 Vehicle Requests

#### ■ Multi-Function Activity Bus \$45,000 (FY17)

- To be used for transportation to athletic and extracurricular events
- Anticipate vehicle could be used anywhere between 45 and 60 athletic runs through out school year.
- The estimated annual savings would be between \$13,500 and \$18,000.

#### Future Vehicle Requests

- Special Education Van \$42,000 (FY 18)
  - **2**007 Ford -250 w/over \$115,000 miles
- Maintenance Vehicle \$50,000 (FY 20)
  - ■2009 Ford -350 w/ over 40,000 miles
- Food Service Vehicle \$45,000 (FY 21)
  - ■2005 Ford -250 w/ over 100,000 miles



#### Technology Requests (FY 17)

- Computer Replacement Plan- \$60,000 (FY17)
  - Add Chrome Book and iPad Carts to Current Fleet
- Elementary Wireless Infrastructure \$100,000 (FY17)
  - Request will align elementary schools with new MS/HS
  - Project involves the replacement of parts and increasing access points to improve network bandwidth
  - State grant with matching funds is a possibility



#### Technology Plan Future Needs (FY18)

- Data Management Software- \$75,000 (FY18)
  - Update data management software
  - New systems will allow district to process state reports more efficiently and thus meet ever—increasing state mandates
  - New software will cost up to \$75,000 and will increase annual maintenance costs by approximately \$15,000
- Continue with Computer Replacement Plan
  - Continue w/ adding and replacing computer devices

#### Facility Plan Requests (FY17)

- Little School Roof Project \$263,450\* (FY 17)
  - \*Estimated Cost for Roof Replacement; Cost is subject to
     Schematic Design and Feasibility Study determination by MSBA
  - Roof is over 25 years old
  - Showing increasing signs of deterioration and decay
  - Extend the life expectancy of the building
  - MSBA reimbursements funds available at 46.58% as part of their accelerated repair program.
  - Project is in the feasibility and design phase



#### Facility Plan Requests (FY17)

- Hood School Parking Lot (Phase 2) \$50,000 (FY 17)
  - Year 2 project would focus on front entranceway and parking lot.
  - Lot is showing signs of deterioration resulting in safety concerns.
  - Plan would be to work with DPW to achieve economies of scale.

#### Facility Plan Future Needs –FY18-FY19

- Energy System Upgrade \$200,000 (FY19)
  - Build on existing system to install full energy management system at both the Hood and Little Schools.
  - If completed the district would maximize their ability to save energy and regulate occupancy schedules throughout each school.
- Asbestos Mitigation- \$50,000 (FY18)
  - FY 18 and FY 20 continue asbestos mitigation projects

## Capital Improvement Planning Committee Timeline

- Capital request sheets due from each department by September 30<sup>th</sup>; School Committee vote to adopt on September 28<sup>th</sup>
- CIPC will review requests and make field trips if necessary to gather all relevant information. (November)
- CIPC members will rank requests. (January)
- Committee will review and come to a consensus of the ranking order. (February/March)
- Plan will involve three years worth of project requests.
- CIPC will present plan to Board of Selectman. (April)
- CIPC will submit final plan and articles for June Town Meeting. (April)
