

#### **INVITATION FOR BIDS**

The School Department for the Town of North Reading, Massachusetts requests sealed bids for on-call labor rates in the following areas: Heating System/Boiler Repair, Plumbing Repair, Roofing/Building Envelope Repair, Refrigeration/HVAC Repair and Electrical Repair.

The North Reading Public Schools are seeking bids for a 1-year contract with the option of up to two 1-year extensions. Sealed bids will be received in the Business Office, 189 Park Street, North Reading, MA 01864, until 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, February 27, 2019. All bids will be publicly opened and read at that time.

Complete information for bidders may be obtained at the North Reading Public Schools Business Office, 189 Park Street, North Reading, MA 01864, Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM until 4:00 PM beginning Monday, January 14, 2019. Bids submitted by mail should be addressed to the North Reading Public Schools Business Office, at 189 Park Street, North Reading, MA 01864 or dropped off at the above address.

The North Reading Public Schools reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or to accept any parts thereof which it considers most advantageous to the Town of North Reading.

#### INVITATION TO BID AND INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

- The North Reading Public Schools are seeking bids for a 1-year contract with the option of up to two 1-year extensions. The North Reading Public Schools is the awarding authority. The successful bidders shall be the ones with the lowest responsive and responsible bids with the demonstrated ability to perform within an acceptable time frame.
- 2. The initial 1-year contract will be for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. Contract extensions beyond the initial 12-month period will be awarded at the sole discretion of the North Reading Public Schools. Additionally, contract extensions beyond the initial 12month period will be subject to available appropriation(s). The North Reading Public Schools reserve the right to not exercise its option(s) for extension(s) and to re-bid the remainder of the contract at the end of each 12-month period if it is deemed in the best interest of the School Department to do so.
- 3. Bids must be made on the forms provided, either in ink or typewritten. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked with the name of the bidder and the words "Maintenance Bid". Bids must be received in the District Administration, 189 Park Street, North Reading, MA 01864 prior to 11:00 AM on Wednesday, February 27, 2019 to the attention of Michael Connelly, Director of Finance and Operations. If for any unforeseen reason the office is closed on that day, the bid deadline will be extended to 11:00 AM on the next business day.
- 4. This bid is divided into five (5) sections: Heating System/Boiler Repair, Plumbing Repair, Roofing/Building Envelope Repair, Refrigeration/HVAC Repair and Electrical Repair. Bidders may bid on any/all sections as appropriate.
- 5. The estimated annual expenditure for each category is listed below. This is based on past experience and is an estimate only. There is no guarantee that this amount of work will actually be required in any specific year.

a.	Heating System/Boiler Repair	\$12,000
b.	Plumbing Repair	\$20,000
C.	Roofing/Building Envelope Repair	\$10,000
d.	HVAC Maintenance /Repair	\$25,000
e.	Electrical Repair	\$18,000

6. This bid is seeking on-call labor rates to be used as needed. There is no specific job being bid at this time. Samples of jobs to be expected are included in each section. Labor shall be billed for on-site hours only with no minimum charge. Labor is <u>not</u> to be billed during so-called "travel time". Any additional charges (other than parts) such as a "trip charge" or "equipment charge" shall be listed separately on the bid form. An "emergency" call shall be one that is placed and responded to between the hours of 6:00 PM and 6:00 AM Monday through Friday, and all day Saturdays, Sundays, and Legal Holidays.

7. Sealed Bids <u>must</u> be accompanied by a bid deposit in the following amount for each category that is being bid on:

Said bid deposit shall be payable to the **North Reading Public Schools** in the form of a Certified, Treasurer's or Cashier's Check, or a Bid Bond written by a surety company authorized to do business in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Bid deposits in the form of a check from the three lowest responsible and eligible bidders shall be returned within thirty working days after opening of the bids. Bid deposits from all other bidders will be returned within 5 working days after the bid opening.

Bidders who bid on more than one category must submit a bid deposit for the total of the categories they have bid on. For example, if you submit a bid for Heating System *and* Plumbing repairs, you must submit a bid deposit of \$2,000.

- 8. The importance of maintaining our buildings and equipment in a satisfactory operating condition demands that the work and services be performed by a contractor who is regularly engaged with his own skilled and competent personnel in the installation and maintenance of equipment of the grade included in the buildings. The bidder must be able to demonstrate that he has satisfactorily performed work and maintenance on equipment of similar control and operation and that he has a local organization and facilities located within a reasonable distance from North Reading to properly fulfill all the work and services required on the type of equipment included within the buildings and that he has the financial and technical ability to render these services. To this end all bidders are required to supply the following information with their bid:
  - a. A company profile, on company letterhead, to include company size, facilities and equipment, and number of permanent, full-time service personnel, including their years of experience, their qualifications and license / certification numbers.
  - b. A list of at least three (3) current customers of your service with similar size buildings and equipment as North Reading, with contact person and phone number. Also list any public agencies which you have serviced in the last three years.
- 9. This is being bid in accordance with MGL Chapter 149, sections 44A-H, inclusive.
- 10. A copy of the Prevailing Wage Rates from the Division of Occupational Safety is included with this Invitation to Bid.

- 11. The successful bidders shall submit an insurance binder showing proof of the following insurances and amount coverages:
  - a. General Liability: \$1,000,000 Aggregate coverage, \$500,000 per person, or a combined \$1,000,000 bodily injury coverage.
  - b. Property Liability: \$1,000,000 Aggregate coverage, \$500,000 per person, or a combined \$1,000,000 property damage coverage.
  - c. Worker's Compensation: In amounts and as required by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
- 12. The successful bidders shall submit proof of having completed at least 10 hours of OSHA training.
- 13. - 15. Rule for award: The District will determine the rule for award based on the hourly rate and % mark-up provided on the bid form. A standard fixed amount of hours and supply amounts will be estimated for each trade and used in the calculation.

#### SCOPE OF SERVICES

#### Section I – Heating System / Boiler Repair

- Perform routine maintenance including cleaning and vacuuming of boilers and burners prior to each heating season.
- Provide all services and equipment necessary to maintain the boilers and burners in a safe, efficient operating condition.
- Open and close boilers as necessary for State inspections.
- Respond to calls for no heat and be able to provide emergency service 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays.
- All service shall only be conducted by properly certified technicians.
- To service boilers located at the Middle School/High School Campus the successful contractor must provide evidence they are licensed to perform work on this equipment:

#### Section II – Plumbing Repair

- Repair / replace damaged plumping fixtures and piping with similar equipment.
- Repair / replace industrial water heaters.
- Repair / replace valves, pumps, and controllers.
- Complete drain cleaning service.
- Be able to provide emergency service 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays.
- All service shall only be conducted by properly licensed technicians.

#### Section III – Roofing / Building Envelope Repair

- Detect and repair roof leaks.
- Repair / replace flashing.
- Repair / replace caulking.
- Repair damaged and leaking skylights and/or roof access hatches
- Repair / replace trim and weather-stripping and any substandard deteriorated structure
- Be able to provide emergency service 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays.
- All service shall only be conducted by properly certified technicians. Must have at least 5 years experience with Carlisle and Firestone EPDM roofing systems, Sarnafil PVC roofing systems, and various types of built-up tar and gravel, slate, roof shingles and metal roofing systems.

#### Section IV – Refrigeration / HVAC Repair

- Perform routine and scheduled maintenance per manufacturer recommendations including air filter changes, drive belts, cleaning and service of all refrigeration equipment, and heating and cooling rooftop air handling systems during each heating and cooling season.
- Provide all services necessary to maintain the heating and cooling functions for rooftop air handling systems and cooling towers in a safe, efficient operating condition.
- Respond to calls for no heat, cooling, and refrigeration and be able to provide emergency service 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays.
- This work includes maintenance on all HVAC equipment at the District's three elementary schools (Batchelder, Hood, & Little Schools) and includes all refrigeration equipment at all five school and campus locations including the Middle School/High School, including the following refrigeration equipment:
  - Walk in Cooler/Freezer Units
  - o IT room wall-mounted units
- All service shall only be conducted by properly certified technicians.

#### **Section V– Electrical Repair**

- Repair / replace damaged electrical fixtures, switches and ballasts with similar equipment and voltage.
- Repair / replace low voltage equipment (i.e. phone lines, exit signs, computer lines, data drops).

- Repair / replace exterior lighting equipment as needed (including aerial lift as needed).
- Upgrades to higher efficiency lighting fixtures as needed or recommended
- Be able to provide emergency service 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays.
- All service shall only be conducted by properly licensed technicians.

Information about Prevailing Wage Schedules for Awarding Authorities and Contractors

• This wage schedule applies only to the specific project referenced at the top of this page and uniquely identified by the "Wage Request Number" on all pages of this schedule.

• An Awarding Authority must request an updated wage schedule from the Department of Labor Standards ("DLS") if it has not opened bids or selected a contractor within 90 days of the date of issuance of the wage schedule. For CM AT RISK projects (bid pursuant to G.L. c.149A), the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the bid for the first construction scope of work must be within 90-days of the wage schedule issuance date.

• The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or any sub-contractor.

• All apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Department of Labor Standards, Division of Apprentice Standards (DLS/DAS). Apprentice must keep his/her apprentice identification card on his/her person during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DLS/DAS regardless of whether or not they are registered with any other federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the journeyworker's rate for the trade.

• The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule. Awarding authorities are required to request these updates no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multi-year CM AT RISK projects, awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. Contractors are required to obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities, and to pay no less than these rates to covered workers. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts.

• Every contractor or subcontractor which performs construction work on the project is required to submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. A sample of a payroll reporting form may be obtained at http://www.mass.gov/dols/pw.

• Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.

• Employees not receiving the prevailing wage rate set forth on the wage schedule may report the violation to the Fair Labor Division of the office of the Attorney General at (617) 727-3465.

• Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to pay the prevailing wage rates listed on the wage schedule to all employees who perform construction work on the project is a violation of the law and subjects the contractor or subcontractor to civil and
