



Applying to Private Schools

- Most private school applications are due in December and January
- Private schools often require letters of recommendation from teachers, and occasionally, guidance counselors or coaches.
- Gateway to Prep, Ravenna-Boston Shared Forms, and The Standard Application Online
- Go to admission page on the private school's website

Requesting Letters of Recommendation

 Please reach out to teachers and staff personally through email, or in person if you plan to ask them for a letter of recommendation. It is important to give them plenty of time to write the letter, so ask them ASAP

DO NOT send/email "Transcript Report Request" or "Principal/Counselor Recommendation" to teachers or the principal (send it to your student's guidance counselor)
